**Responsibilities:**

Assist the Food Bank and Drop-In team with the following tasks:

- Support Pizza Oven and Good Food Market volunteers
- Complete administrative tasks associated with the Good Food Market (food ordering, accounting, statistics etc.)
- Support Food Bank and Drop-in service delivery and programming
